We choose these individuals because they represent all of the different stakeholder groups within the Oconomowoc Community

Team Meetings are held monthly for 2 hours. Subcommittee’s also meet to work on projects.

Challenges-

- *collecting data across different departments (e.g. each department gather data differently)
- *not having enough time & resources

Opportunities -

- *Due to the diversity of team members we are able to “think outside” the box, when it comes to creating programs/implementation

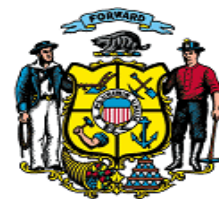
